

# Impact Report 2025



We are proud to be one of the projects actively offering solutions to support independent living - helping make cycling not just possible, but a genuine choice for Disabled People. We run cycle sessions & rides in parks, road, off-road and closed circuit. We also run an e-cycle loan scheme, and work across South Yorkshire to secure better infrastructure, support and recognition for the disabled cycling community.

## In 2025, we...

- supported over **900 Disabled People and 600 carers** at our cycling sessions
- had on average over **60 Disabled People and 40 carers cycling with us each week**, building confidence, skills and community
- trialled new and expanded sessions at Parkwood Springs, Hillsborough Park, Herringthorpe Playing Fields and Concord Park



- **loaned e-cycles to 24 people** to try out cycling independently, 6 went on to buy their own, 2 we supported with funding bids
- **reached 685 people through outreach events** across South Yorkshire, spreading the message that cycling really can be for everyone

From everyday cycle sessions, we continue to see small moments make a big difference — from someone gaining confidence over a couple of cups of tea, to a carer cycling for the first time...
