## Proud Moments from 2025 (Part 1)



In 2025 **Sheffield Cycling 4 All** celebrated some amazing moments, lets have a look at some:



We supported **over 900 Disabled People** and 600 carers at our cycling sessions



We welcomed over **400 new Disabled People** and 270 carers.



We had over **60 Disabled People** and **40 carers** cycling with us each week.



**198 people** took part in our new and expanded sessions.

## Proud Moments from 2025 (Part 2)

**24 people** loaned an electric cycle from our scheme. **6 people** bought their own and we supported **2 people** with funding.



Through organising and going to events we engaged with **685 people** throughout **South Yorkshire**



Through the work we have done, we have shown that cycling really is for **everyone.**
